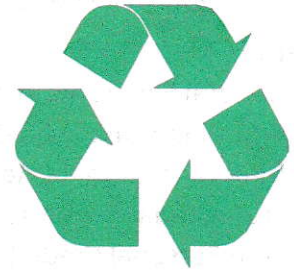

## Corporate Recycling Programs

- [GiveBackBox.com](http://GiveBackBox.com): Donate old clothing/household goods. Box up, print labels & ship free to Goodwill.
- [Goodwill of Central Indiana](#): Accept computers, televisions and electronics.
- [Staples](#): Take electronics, keyboards, mice, ink cartridges, batteries, etc. regardless of where purchased.
- [Best Buy](#): Recycles most electronics and home appliances. Sometimes gives store credit.
- [Lowes / Home Depot](#): Take compact fluorescent light bulbs, batteries and plastic bags.
- [Walmart / Target](#): All stores have plastic and aluminum bins.
- [Amazon Trade-In](#): Earn credit for old phones, TVs, video games, electronics, and books.
- [Apple/Google](#): Free recycling programs; store credits available for some devices.
- [Verizon, Sprint, AT&T](#): Recycle cell phones to benefit domestic violence charities; possible store credit.
